The induction arrangements are as follows:

- Mrs Goodchild hopes to visit primary schools during April and May to meet your child. If your child has any questions she will answer them on her visit
- We would like to invite your child to visit us on Thursday 11 July. The purpose of the visit is to enable the new students to meet each other and to experience being a student at The Astley Cooper. On 11 July, your child should arrive at school at 9:00am; they will be met at the gate by school staff. They will follow a specific timetable for the day and finish at 2:30pm. Lunch will be at 12:00pm. Please send your child with £2.50 to spend in the canteen. If your child has free school meals, we will liaise with their primary school and make the necessary arrangements with the canteen. All students should bring a full pencil case, a PE kit and be in their current school uniform
