School Sports Day – Friday 10th July / Tuesday 14th July

I am writing to confirm arrangements for this year's School Sports Day.

Due to the extremely warm weather forecast, the arrangements for this year's sports day have been amended.

On Friday 10th July all students should arrive to school in full PE kit. They also have the option of wearing a plain T – shirt (no football shirts) of the colour of their house if they prefer. They will then stay in PE kit for the duration of the day.

Please note all students should arrive to school at their normal start time. After being registered, students will then be lead to the field by their tutors.

Numerous activities including field events, football and Tug of War will be from 8:45AM – 11:00AM.

After break students will return to the top field to participate or spectate in the relay races. Students will then have lunch at the usual time and P4 and P5 lessons will continue as normal.

The weather forecast is currently predicting that temperatures will rise to over 30 degrees by the afternoon. We have therefore taken the decision to postpone the track events.

Track Events will now take place on the morning of Tuesday 14th July from 9AM – 11AM. Students should arrive to school in full PE kit. They also have the option of wearing a plain T – shirt of the colour of their house if they prefer. They will then stay in PE kit for the duration of the day.

Please ensure your child has a water bottle, sun cream and a hat on both days.
