Ofsted Inspection of The Astley Cooper School on 8 & 9 June 2016

Following the recent inspection of our school, I am pleased to inform you that the inspection report will be published on our website today and on the Ofsted website at www.ofsted.gov.uk on 18 July.

I am delighted to tell you that Ofsted has judged us as a *Good* school. Ofsted recognises that the effectiveness of leadership and management, quality of teaching, learning and assessment, and the personal development, behaviour and welfare of students are all Good. This is the first time in the school's history that Astley Cooper has reached this benchmark – a significant moment for us all.

Ofsted say that 'The overall quality of teaching is good and improving,' and 'relationships between staff and students are good.' Our students behaved extremely well over the two day inspection. The inspectors commented that 'Lessons are calm and purposeful and most pupils want to do well.'
